Job Description: Small ruminant Vet Assistant and Embryologist for our Breeding Services Division.

This individual will work alongside our veterinarians to assure the success of our sheep and goat breeding programs. The position will play a key role in embryo collections, grading and transfers while being involved in our expansion into IVF. This position reports to the Breeding Services Team Lead.

- Searching and grading of small ruminant embryos.
- Preparing embryos for transfer into recipient females.
- Maintain good laboratory technique and follow lab protocols.
- Recordkeeping/Data Entry
- Assist in Quality Control and lab cleanliness
- Providing Vet Assistance for LAI and other procedure work.
- Learning oocyte searching and grading for maturation for IVF
- Follow RSG's policies and procedures
- Maintain a professional image reflective of RSG's industry leadership in small ruminant reproduction.
- Other duties may include feeding and animal care of in-house donor and recip program, assisting the Frozen Genetics team with male collections, freezing and processing.
- Work as a team player at all times.
