- **About the Role**

This individual will work alongside our veterinarians to ensure the success of our sheep and goat breeding programs. The position will play a key role in embryo collections, grading and transfers while being involved in our expansion into IVF. This position reports to the Breeding Services Team Lead.

- **Master embryology protocols and lab standards** — Demonstrate full competency in the RSG embryology manual, including accurate searching, grading, and evaluation of embryos, while maintaining good laboratory technique, quality control, and lab cleanliness in accordance with all RSG protocols.
- **Execute embryo transfer and advanced reproductive procedures** — Accurately move embryos from donors to recipients, prepare embryos for transfer into recipient females, and support laparoscopic artificial insemination and embryo transfer days, including learning oocyte searching and grading for IVF maturation.
- **Manage veterinary inventory and field logistics** — Monitor consumable usage, efficiently plan supply reorders, complete packing lists, and ensure all equipment and supplies are properly packed and sterilized for on-road breeding programs and surgical procedures.
- **Support semen collection, processing, and frozen genetics** — Perform competent semen collection, processing, and assessment for ET LAI and LAI days, demonstrate proficiency in handling and thawing frozen semen, and assist the Frozen Genetics team with male collections, freezing, and processing as needed.
- **Administer anesthesia and provide veterinary assistance** — Gain full understanding of anesthetic procedures for related surgeries, carry them out as required, and provide hands-on veterinary assistance for LAI and other procedure work.
- **Maintain accurate records and compliance logs** — Keep precise medical records, data entry, and computer records current, and maintain accurate controlled substance logs for the assigned veterinary team in full compliance with RSG policies.
- **Ensure accurate client charging and financial records** — Verify QuickBooks account accuracy, collect client payments on the day of

procedure, and maintain up-to-date financial records reflective of all services rendered.
