This individual will work alongside our veterinarians to ensure the success of our sheep and goat breeding programs. The position will play a key role in embryo collections, grading and transfers while being involved in our expansion into IVF. This position reports to the Breeding Services Team Lead.

- **Learn and apply foundational embryology skills** — Begin developing competency in searching and grading small ruminant embryos under supervision, follow lab protocols, and maintain good laboratory technique and cleanliness.
- **Assist with embryo transfer procedures** — Support the preparation of embryos for transfer into recipient females and assist experienced team members during laparoscopic AI and embryo transfer days.
- **Support veterinary inventory and supply management** — Help monitor consumable inventory, assist in packing equipment and supplies for field programs, and learn the reordering process for veterinary supplies.
- **Assist with semen collection and frozen genetics** — Learn the basics of semen collection, processing, and handling alongside the Frozen Genetics team, and develop foundational skills in thawing and assessing frozen semen.
- **Provide veterinary procedure assistance** — Shadow and assist licensed veterinary staff during LAI and other reproductive procedures, and begin building an understanding of anesthesia protocols used in surgical settings.
- **Develop accurate recordkeeping habits** — Learn to accurately complete medical records, data entry, and controlled substance logs under supervision, following RSG's documentation standards from day one.
- **Support animal care and daily operations** — Assist with feeding and care of in-house donor and recipient animals, contribute to lab quality control, and take on additional duties that support the broader team.
